Over 120 volunteers, most of whom are cancer survivors and members of DBC, wrangled, steered, marshaled, sold merchandise, fed the masses, coordinated, and celebrated the festival teams' successes.

We're always trying new things and this year was no different! The inaugural Festival Online Auction raised over \$6,000 for our festival teams. Prizes were given away weekly to top fundraisers and included chances to win dinners at Texas Roadhouse and family four-packs from The RiverDogs. Festival goers were treated to entertainment by the Chinese Academy and the Chinese Association of Greater Charleston. Karon Boatwright, Pound Pro Tour Crew and Kris Franzen, Pound Pro, showcased POUND's high-energy workout. And the children's dragon parade was a blast!!

The big question is how much was raised? Donations exceeded \$117,000 this year, just shy of our goal of \$120,000.
